Fabrizio, Lee & Associates just completed a survey of N=300 likely Primary voters in California's 45th Congressional District.

- **Rep. Porter leads in the initial ballot thanks in part to being the lone Democrat running while Greg Raths is the top choice among the Republicans in the field.**

Greg Raths receives vote support from nearly a quarter (23%) of the likely Republican primary voters. No other Republican tested receives more than 4% support from Republican voters.

- **After giving voters a handful of messages and biographical information about Greg Raths, his vote support climbs to 26% overall.**

After hearing messages about Greg Raths and about some of his biographical information, his ballot score jumps to 26% overall. The post-messaging ballot has Raths garnering a majority of the Republican vote (53%).

METHODOLOGY STATEMENT: Fabrizio, Lee & Associates conducted a districtwide survey of 300 likely 2020 primary voters from August 15-18, 2019 in California Congressional District 45. Landline interviews accounted for 50% of the sample and cell phone interviews 50%. Geography was matched to past voter turnout in recent primary elections within the district. Gender, age, and race/ethnicity were matched to district characteristics. Respondents were randomly selected from lists of known primary election voters. The margin of error at the 95% confidence interval for 300 voters is $\pm 5.66\%$.
